QUICK REFERENCE COMPETITION RULES 2026-2027 SEASON

'CLUB' are formal comps (competitions), usually evaluated by an invited judge. The points that the judge awards to each member's image are accrued during the WPS 'season', the member who accrues the most points being the **WPS POTY** ('Photographer of the Year'). There are two sub-divisions, **'Print POTY'** and **'PDI POTY'**. If a tie breaker situation occurs, the member who has the greater number of higher placed images is the winner.

'FRIENDLY' are informal comps judged by the WPS members on the night. The results of these **DO NOT** count in respect of **'POTY'**.

'WHEN' was the image taken?

'ANY' means at **any time**. ******* means 365 days prior to the closing date of comp as per current season Programme.

You can enter an image into a maximum of three **FRIENDLY** comps, but once that image has been placed in the TOP THREE, it cannot be entered into another **FRIENDLY** comp, but it can be subsequently entered into a **CLUB** comp.

An image previously entered into a **CLUB** comp cannot be entered into a **FRIENDLY** comp, one exception being the AV Friendly comp where the member may need to use many images to compile an AV.

You can enter an image into a maximum of three **CLUB** comps, but once that image has been placed in the TOP THREE, it cannot be entered into another **CLUB** or **FRIENDLY** comp, but you can still enter it into the **'Image Of The Year'** comp. Once you have entered any image into an **'Image Of The Year'** comp, you cannot enter that image into **ANY** later competitions, either **CLUB** or **FRIENDLY**.

PHOTOENTRY

ANY IMAGE you enter into a **CLUB** comp irrespective of whether it is a PRINT or PDI comp, must be uploaded to **PhotoEntry** before the competition closing date. Prints also must be handed in by the closing date. All closing dates are listed on the preceding Programme. Members unable to upload, or meet these deadlines for circumstances beyond their control may be granted an extension by the Competition Secretary where possible.

Copies uploaded to PhotoEntry must be in sRGB colour spectrum and .jpeg image format.

The size of your uploaded copy, must not exceed 1600 pixels **horizontally** and 1200 pixels **vertically** (but can be less).

It is advisable to place a thin contrasting border of about 2 pixels around your image to aid projection (against a black background). Do this **before** you resize to fit the 1600 x 1200 limits.

IMPORTANT! When you resize your image, make sure you save the new smaller image with a DIFFERENT NAME, in order to preserve your original image.

NOTE it is not essential that you Re-size and convert to sRGB as PHOTOENTRY will do it for you, BUT BEWARE, this may not produce an image to YOUR satisfaction. We advise that you do it. PhotoEntry will NOT upsize a smaller image.

Inter-Club

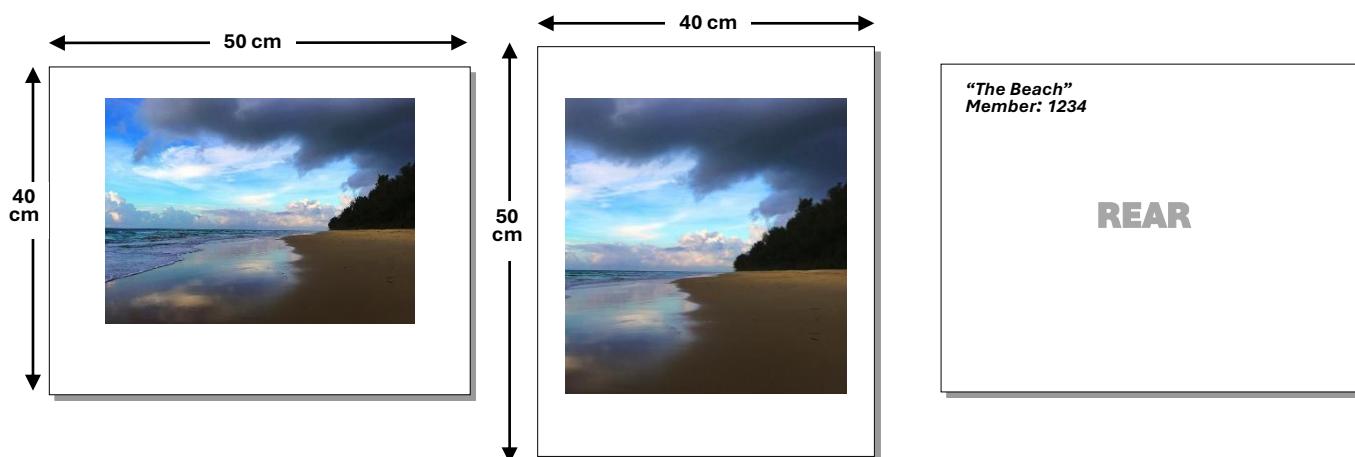
WPS enters a number of Inter-Club Competitions during the season. Selection Meetings comprising of Committee Members and invited Club Members are held regularly to decide what images are suitable for entry.

Members who do not want their images entered into Inter-Club competitions should inform a committee member.

PRINTS

A print can be any size, provided it is mounted **within** a standard 500mm x 400mm mountboard, presented in Landscape or Portrait format.

A mountboard can be any colour, but please consider the comments at the bottom of the page regarding Judges.



There are three ways you can mount your print:

1. **THIS IS THE PREFERRED METHOD** Cut a hole in your mountboard *fractionally* smaller than your print, affix your print to it, and then affix a full backing board using double sided tape or adhesive.– note that mountboards can be purchased with pre-cut holes to accommodate A4 or A3 prints, but this may hinder your creativity by restricting the dimensions of your image.
2. Alternative 2, fix your print directly onto the face of a standard mountboard using spray adhesive or double-sided tape.
3. Alternative 3, once you have cut your mountboard and affixed your print to it (as in 1), affix a smaller backing board. Note that prior to competitions, prints are stored on top of each other. If you secure a smaller mountboard using sticky tape, please ensure that this is **FIRMLY AFFIXED** and cannot peel, as this could damage somebody else's work stored below.

On the **TOP REAR LEFT CORNER** of any print submitted, you must write the **TITLE** of your image and your **WPS MEMBERSHIP NUMBER (not your name)**. PLEASE ENSURE THIS IS CLEARLY LEGIBLE = NOT WRITTEN FAINTLY WITH A THIN PENCIL ON A GRAY BACKING BOARD. USE BLACK PEN, OR A FIRMLY AFFIXED LABEL. During the competition, this information needs to be clear in DIM LIGHT.

WPS will not be responsible for damage to an image caused by incorrect mounting.

ADVICE REGARDING IMAGES AND JUDGES

All Judges have their own preferences.

- Some on occasion may mark an image down for being poorly mounted.
- Some may consider a mountboard colour to be inappropriate.
- Some may mark an image down for not having a border on a PDI showing the outline of a projected image.
- Conversely, some may mark an image down for having too big a border, or a border colour that they consider inappropriate.
- Some may consider the title of your image to be inappropriate or misleading.

Please think about these points carefully when you enter a competition.
